## Das Verhör von Habana

Die zehn Verhöre dieses Buches nehmen einer geschlagenen Klasse, der cubanischen Bourgeoisie, ein Selbstbildnis ab, in dem ihre verborgensten Regungen zum Vorschein kommen. Ort und Zeit der Handlung: Habana nach der gescheiterten Invasion an der Schweinebucht. Hauptfiguren: die gefangenen Söldner, rekrutiert aus der cubanischen Emigration in Miami, ausgerüstet und bezahlt von der CIA.

Vorlage der Rekonstruktion: ein offizielles Tonband-Protokoll aus cubanischen Archiven. Beigaben: Essay, Fotos, Dokumente, Lebensläufe, Materialien.

Enzensbergers Buch hat es nicht auf exotische Geschichtsforschung abgesehen. Es zeigt, an Hand eines historischen Glückfalls, den inneren Mechanismus einer Klassengesellschaft. Der Sieg der cubanischen Revolution hat ihr Gehäuse aufgebrochen und den Blick ins Innere eines Uhrwerks freigelegt, das auch in unserer Gesellschaft tickt.

## Freisprüche. Revolutionäre vor Gericht

Fünfundzwanzig Revolutionäre vor Gericht, von Babeuf (1797), in dem man den ersten Kommunisten sehen kann, bis zu Kuron und Modzelewski (1965), zwei jungen Polen, die heute noch im Gefängnis sitzen. Die Rechtskraft der Urteile reicht nur soweit wie die Macht der herrschenden Klasse, die sie gefällt hat: der Titel des Buches, ein Castro-Zitat, nimmt ihre Revision vorweg. Vergessene stehen neben Klassikern, Asiaten, Afrikaner und Lateinamerikaner neben Europäern. Mehr als die Hälfte der Texte wird in Deutschland zum ersten Mal publiziert. Biographien und Kommentare stellen den historischen Kontext her. In diesem politischen Lesebuch kommt es nicht auf die juristische Seite von einigen sensationellen Prozessen an, sondern auf das Selbstverständnis der revolutionären Bewegungen, auf ihr Verhältnis zur Staatsmacht und auf ihre Strategien zu deren Sturz.
